Thank you for reviewing or plan for Sevoy Antiques Warehouse proposed for the northwest corner of Fairview Avenue and Barbara Drive.

Based on our conversation on October 13, 2004 as well as my previous conversation with Elroy Huff, It is my understanding that the Meridian Parks and Recreation Department is supportive of the concept presented in the preliminary plan you reviewed the week of October 11, 2004 and is reiterated in the attached plan dated October 17, 2004. These plans depict the required 10 foot wide pathway along Five Mile Creek being achieved by providing a section of hardscape that abuts the proposed building. The design also provides a guardrail to prevent path users from falling down the steep creek bank.
